Gaye is a member of the Kansas Appleseed Board of Directors and focuses her advocacy on reducing child hunger in Kansas. She is a partner at Hite, Fanning & Honeyman, L.L.P.

Robinson is also a partner at Hite, Fanning & Honeyman, L.L.P. Robinson advocates for judicial independence and serves as the steering committee chair for Kansans for Fair Courts. Kansans for Fair Courts and Kansas Appleseed worked together to defend the independence of Kansas’s judicial system and defeated proposed legislation that would have ended the merit selection of justices in Kansas.
